

Board Nominations Information & Process

Overview of Nominations Process

- 1. Board members are asked to nominate potential new members by completing a Board Nomination Recommendation Form by August 31, 2022.
- 2. Nominating Advisory Group reviews submitted nominations in early September. The Group may consider nominations from previous years for nominees who did not yet join the board.
- 3. Members from the Advisory Group contact prospects to confirm interest/willingness to serve.
- 4. Advisory Group brings forward those names to the Board for approval at the October Board meeting.
- 5. New members attend Orientation in December, and begin new terms in January 2023.

Vacancies & Needs for 2023 Board

- Two Board members will complete their second terms on the board (Bynoe, Lee).
- Four Board members complete their first terms and the Executive Director and/or Board President will be discussing second terms with each.
- Based on this, we anticipate having 17 continuing elected board members.
- MPCF Bylaws allow for up to 25 elected board members (plus 2 ex-officio and 4 representative).
- In order to stagger terms and bring new members in over time, we recommend adding **3-5 new** board members in 2023.
- Skill sets/specific areas of expertise we will be looking for in 2023 board members:
 - a. experience and/or interest in **fundraising**;
 - experience and/or desire to engage in public service (particularly within leadership capacity);
 - c. high level of social and business contacts;
 - d. knowledge of **estate planning**/legacy giving;
 - e. **legal** background/expertise;
 - f. personal commitment to **philanthropy**, connection to **MPC**, and/or **passion** for higher education.
- The Board is committed to an equitable and inclusive process and ensuring recruitment of individuals who represent the diverse nature of our community.
