5. Athletics Update (Wendy Bates)
 - Wendy started her update by sharing that MPC players are competing, although there has been a lot of re-scheduling due to the rain. All sports that are in season are going.
 - Recruiting is also happening right now and some prospective students are visiting campus, but depending on the sport, this can happen year round.
 - Erin added that the Lobos Zone space is being utilized more and more. The academic advisor, Jordan, is using the space more for scheduling meetings and academic-driven activities.
 - Wendy also shared that Athletics is looking to do a recognition ceremony for graduating athletes (this will be the first one) and this will happen in the gym.

6. Continue Discussing Lobos Zone Fundraising & Other 2023 Plans (Beccie Michael)
 - The promo tote for Lobos Zone introduction campaign is ready. We will be collecting names and emails to tell people all about Boosters and Lobos Zone. There is also some swag and some Booster t-shirts that we can offer for a voluntary donation. Amber and Wendy will have the tote at the game for the Booster Committee members to table at the event. This will include a table, a tablecloth and all the info inside the tote.
 - We are hoping to promote the website and the giving page with our athletes before we tell the community about the Lobos Zone
 - The next Booster Enews will have the big announcement that will include a video for the Lobos Zone.
 - The committee discussed the possible games to table for Lobos Zone. Beccie will share a google sheet for sign-ups.
 - The committee agreed the main point of tabling is spreading awareness about our Lobos Zone and directing people to the landing page/email sign up. The second component was the Lobos shirts, and the committee agreed that it will be cash based.
 - Beccie will send out an email with more details soon.

7. Discussing Fundraising Collaboration with Alumni Committee (Sharon Osgood)
 - Sharon explained the idea of a Pickle Ball tournament for in spring 2024. She explained some of the logistics and how it could make money for both Alumni and Boosters.
 - The committee discussed the idea and agreed it would be a good partnership for the Boosters and Alumni Committees.
 - The Alumni Committee is hoping to raise \$10K for their scholarship and the same amount for Athletics/Boosters.
 - The committee continued to discuss various possibilities of the event.
 - Sharon suggested that the Booster Committee picks a couple of representatives (2 people) to talk to the Alumni Committee and develop more detailed plans. Tom and Wendy will be the two representatives of Boosters to meet about the event and Nick and Erin will help as we get closer to the event.
