1. Meeting Called to Order by Tom Clifford at 10:07 a.m.
2. Recognition of Guests: None
3. Public Comment: None
4. Approval of September 8, 2023, Minutes (Tom Clifford)  
Approval of the minutes was tabled to the next meeting.
5. Athletics Update (Wendy Bates)
  - Wendy started her update by sharing that Men's and Women's Basketball started this past weekend, both teams won.
  - Football beat Cabrillo, and are undefeated with 4-0 in conference, tied with San Jose State with two games to go.
  - Soccer will finish up at the end of this week, there was a sophomore gathering with Hartnell that was nice.
  - Men's and Women's Cross Country both qualified for State. Men finished 8<sup>th</sup> in NorCal and Women finished 3<sup>rd</sup>, which was a great accomplishment.
  - Our new athletic trainer is on board since October.
